COLE RITES HELD AT PISGAH CHURCH

Wm. H. Cole, 85, Passed Away Nov. 25; Brother of Mrs. J. O. Morris of Pisgah

Funeral services for W. H. Cole were held at the Pisgah Baptist church Tuesday afternoon November 26, with Rev. G. A. Craig officiating. Burial was in the Christian church cemetery.

The following nephews, Clay Morris, L. B. Morris, H. B. Morris, Snode Morris, and W. C. Morris, and L. L. Morris were pallbearers.

William Henry Cole was born December 6, 1855 at Pisgah, Mo., son of Andrew Briscoe and Rebecca Ann Cole. He grew to manhood in the Pisgah community and was united in marriage with Sudie Douglas. He immediately moved to the state of Kansas where he resided for about five years, returning to Cooper County, Missouri where he settled on a farm near Pisgah where both he and his wife became members of the Pisgah Christian church. He later moved to Cole County in December, 1919, where he resided on a farm near Centertown until he departed from this life at 12:15 a.m. November 25, 1940. The cause of his death was cerebral hemorrhage.

He leaves to mourn his passing: one sister, Mrs. J. O. Morris, of near Pisgah; one brother, G. T. Cole of Kansas City, Mo.; two sons, C. W. and J. D. Cole, eleven grandchildren and two great grandchildren. His wife, one sister, one brother, and two daughters preceded him in death.
