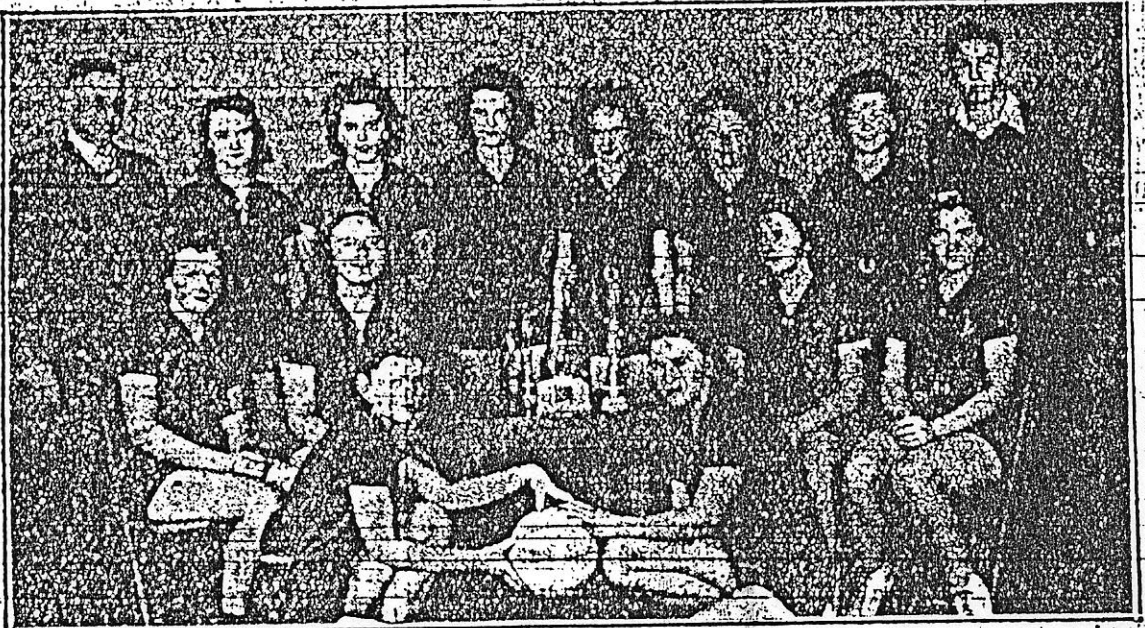


Graduating Class of 1941 at Prairie Home
