

Rites Held For Howard Judge

NEW FRANKLIN — Presiding Judge Robert E. McGavock of Howard county died at his home 3½ miles east of New Franklin Monday morning at 6 o'clock.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the Christian church; the services will be conducted by the Rev. H. C. Clark of Boonville. Burial will be in the Mount Pleasant cemetery, north of New Franklin. The body will lie in state at the Duncan Funeral home until time for the service Wednesday.

Mr. McGavock was born in Howard County, Sept. 3, 1876; and spent his entire life in Howard county. He was elected presiding judge of the Howard county court in the fall of 1940.

Mr. McGavock was the son of Garden C. and Lucy Lewis McGavock.
