

Andrew C. Smith Dies Sunday Morning

Andrew C. Smith, well known and prominent farmer of the Lone Elm community, died at the Alex van Ravenswaay hospital Sunday morning at 10:30 after a long illness. He had been in failing health for about a year.

Brief funeral services were held at the home at 3 o'clock Tuesday afternoon, while church services were held at 3:30 at the Lone Elm Lutheran church, conducted by the Rev. J. W. Schoech, pastor of the church. Burial was in the church cemetery. ✓

Mr. Smith was born and reared in the Lone Elm community. He was a member of the Zion Lutheran church and was active in church work until ill health forced him to give up many activities about a year ago.

He was born Oct. 10, 1878, near Lone Elm, the son of Henry and Julia Hosp Smith. On Sept. 24, 1902, he was married to Miss Esther Brandes. Two children were born to this union.
