Mrs. Clara Seat Dies This Morning

Funeral Services Will Be
Sunday Afternoon at the
Sweeney Funeral Home

Mrs. Clara Ray Seat, 77 years of age, passed away at 11 o'clock this morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. W. F. Lacy and Mr. Lacy, who live south of Marshall. Mrs. Seat, who had been ill only a few days, was taken Monday to the Lacy home where she received every attention available.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Sweeney Funeral Home. Interment will be in the family lot in Ridge Park cemetery. The body is at the funeral home where it will remain until after the service.

Mrs. Seat was born at Boonville, Cooper County, May 25, 1866. In 1882 she was married to Herman L. Seat who preceded her in death in 1922. Two children were born to this union, a son, Arthur W. Seat, who preceded her in death, having passed away about twenty-five years ago, and a daughter, Mabel, now Mrs. W. F. Lacy. She is also survived by a half brother, J. E. Sorg of Joplin, Mo., two grandchildren, Marvin Mistler, 550 South Lyon, and Mrs. Wayne Krager, 953 South Lafayette, and four great grandchildren.

Mrs. Seats, who had been a resident of Marshall for the last forty-two years, had made her home at 561 West Washington for the last forty years.
