## Mrs. Urban A. Smith Dies In Kansas City

Mrs. Urban A. Smith, formerly of Boonville, died at St. Luke's Hospital, Kansas City, yesterday at 2:15 p. m. of a heart attack following an operation.

The body was brought to Boonville this morning and funeral services will be conducted at St. Peter and Paul's Catholic Church Monday at 10 a. m. The Rev. W. F. Roels will conduct the rites. Burial will be in the Catholic Cemetery. The body will remain at the Goodman and Boller Funeral Parlors until time for the services. The Rosary will be recited Sunday at 8 p. m. at the Funeral Parlors.

She is survived by five children, Mrs. Walter B. Beams, Mrs. Kermit W. Hardinger, Mrs. Thomas C. Warrens, Kenneth J. Smith and Jerome P. Smith; three grandsons; three sisters, Mrs. Elizabeth Fluke, Mrs. H. L. Drennen, and Mrs. I. M. Verts; and by one brother, Tyre Tucker.

Mrs. Smith was the former Miss Sadie Tucker. She was born in Cooper County, Feb. 8, 1880, the daughter of Robert and Sarah Parker Tucker. She was married to Urban A. Smith, Oct. 18, 1906. He preceded her in death. Mrs. Smith lived in this community until 1931 when she moved to Kansas City to make her home.
