Thomas Stull Dies Here This Morning

Thomas Stull, 81, 902 Wilkes Boulevard, died shortly before noon today at the Boone County hospital. He had been ill about six weeks and was admitted to the hospital two weeks ago.

Mr. Stull, a retired farmer, was born May 27, 1867, in Schuyler county and came as a boy to Boone county where he has lived practically all his life. He was a member of the Christian church.

Survivors include his widow, the former Miss Lucy Cary; two sons, Cecil Stull of 109 Third avenue and Dysart Stull of 902 Wilkes boulevard; one daughter, Mrs. Nadine Parker, Wilkes boulevard; one sister, Mrs. Mary Burks of Hannibal; 10 grandchildren and one great grandchild.

The body was taken to the Willett Funeral home. No definite funeral arrangements have been made.
