Illness Fatal To Mrs. H. R. Starke

OTTERVILLE, Dec. 22—Mrs. H. Rogers Starke, Otterville, died at Bothwell Hospital, Sedalla, Sunday. She had been critically ill for about two weeks and had been a patient at the hospital since Dec. 5.

Mrs. Starke was news correspondent for the Daily News-Advertiser for more than 20 years, joining the staff in 1929.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Otterville Methodist church. The Rev. H. A. Wood and the Rev. William Sampson conducted the rites. Pallbearers were Edgar Lewis, Weller Hockaday, P. E. Hays, J. H. Gunn, J. Lawrence Moore, and Preston Hays. Burial was in the IOOF cemetery in Otterville. ✓
