

## Silas Hurt, 82, Dies Suddenly

~~Silas Hurt, 82, who served as~~  
deputy under three Cooper County  
sheriffs, was found dead at his  
home at 804 Pendleton Ave., yes-  
terday. He apparently died some-  
time Saturday of a heart attack.

Mr. Hurt complained of not feel-  
ing well Saturday and when  
neighbors saw Saturday and Sun-  
day newspapers on the porch at  
his home local police were called.  
The body was found in a chair  
in the home.

Funeral arrangements are in-  
complete pending the arrival of a  
son, Waldo, McAllister, Okla.  
Rites probably will be held at the  
Goodman and Boller Chapel to-  
morrow afternoon with burial in  
Walnut Grove Cemetery.

✓ He is survived by the one son,  
a grandson, and a number of  
nieces and nephews.

Mr. Hurt was born in Cooper  
County, the son of Acrey B. and  
Matilda Rackard Hurt, and spent  
all of his life in this county. He  
was the last member of his imme-  
diate family. His wife, Mrs. Della  
Hurt, died in October, 1933.

Mr. Hurt taught school in the  
county for many years and later  
was employed at the Missouri  
Training School for Boys.
