Memorial Services Will Be Held Tomorrow for 139 Old Settlers

Memorial services at the Old Settler's reunion at Huntsville tomorrow will be conducted under the direction of the Rev. F. T. Adams, president of the association, in the Baptist Church beginning at 10:30 o'clock.

The list of 139 old settlers who have died since the last annual meeting will be read by Hosea J. Taylor, secretary. There were 16

more deaths than during the preceding year; 69 who died were men and 70 were women.

Miss Sarah Alice Miles, 97, was the oldest of the women, and B. F. Andrews, just short of the century mark, 99, was the oldest man.

Most-Deaths in November

The greatest number of deaths—16—was in the month of November. The month of December usu-

ally has the highest death rate.

Ten who died were 90 or more, compared with 18 last year; 55 were 80 or more compared with the same number last year, 45 were 70 or more compared with 43 last year.
