Rites Monday For Mrs. Nellie Morgan

Mrs. Nellie Brown Morgan died at the Haas Convalescent Home yesterday at 4:30 p. m. following an illness of about one year. Funeral services will be held at the Goodman and Boiler Chapel Monday afternoon 2 o'clock, conducted by the Rev. E. F. Abele. Burial will be in the Walnut Grove Cemetery. The body will remain at the funeral home until time of the rites.

Mrs. Morgan was born in Cooper County, July 18, 1871, the daughter of Robert E. and Rebecca Hurt Brown, and spent all of her life in this community. On Sept. 17, 1889 she was married to Harry C. Morgan, who preceded her in death July 19 1946.

She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Florence Hurt of the home, and Mrs. A. H. Clarke of Los Angeles, Calif., both of whom were with her at the time she died; one granddaughter, Grace M. Clarke, of Reseda, Calif., and one sister, Mrs. Julia Bates, of Huntington Park, Calif.
