

Lifelong Resident Of County Dies

Arthur Maddex, lifelong resident of Cooper county, died at St. Joseph Hospital at 6:25 p. m. Sunday, after a few days illness.

Funeral services were held at the Goodman & Boller Chapel Tuesday afternoon at 2:30, with the Rev. W. C. Smith, of Sedalia, officiating. Burial was in the Walnut Grove Cemetery. ✓
