Reuben H. Powers Died This Morning

Reuben H. Powers, 80, passed away at 4:45 o'clock this morning at the home of his grandson, O. M. Harris and Mrs. Harris, 217 Park Avenue. Mr. Powers had been in failing health for some time, but his condition had been serious the last three weeks.

Funeral services will be at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon in the Sweeney chapel and burial will be in Ridge Park cemetery. The body will remain at the funeral home through the service.

Mr. Powers was born in Dickenson county, Va., May 23, 1877, the son of Hiram and Ollie Ritchie Powers.
