## Burial Tuesday For N. Z. Goode

OTTERVILLE—Funeral services for Neil Z. Goode, who died Sunday at Cedar City, Mo., were Tuesday afternoon at the Hay and Painter funeral home with the Rev. F. L. Cole Jr. officiating.

Burial was at the Otterville I. O. O. F. cemetery.

Mr. Goode, a retired Missouri Pacific railroad employe, died at the home of a daughter, Mrs. John Armstrong, where he had been living the past several months.
