## Mrs. A. L. Yarnell Rites in Clarksburg

CLARKSBURG — Mrs. Almedia Lula Yarnell, 74, died Tuesday night at her home here of a heart attack.

She was born in Cooper county Dec. 8, 1886, the daughter of William Evans and Gertrude Rau Evans. On Oct. 10, 1906, she was married to Ward Yarnell.

Surviving are the husband of the home; three sons, Floyd of Kansas City, Lloyd of Sedalia and postmaster E. W. Yarnell of Clarksburg; one daughter, Mrs. Frances Irene Wolf of Kansas City; eight grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. Two brothers, Ben Evans of Kansas City and Charles of Sedalia, and one sister, Mrs. Perry Steiler of Sedalia, also survive.

Most of Mrs. Yarnell's life was spent in the central Missouri area. Eighteen months ago they moved to Clarksburg after Mr. Yarnell retired.

Funeral services were held today at the Clarksburg Methodist Church under the direction of J. L. Freeman. Her grandsons acted as pallbearers. Burial was in the Sappington Cemetery at the north edge of Clarksburg.
