Robert L. Renno (Sweet Spring)

Robert L. Renno, 83, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Russell Banks, Sweet Springs, at 11 p.m. Friday. He had been in failing health for several months.

He was born in Saline County in the Nelson community, June 17, 1879, son of the late William and Debra Marlin Renno. He lived all of his life in Saline and Pettis counties, engaging in farming until he retired. He has lived in Sedalia since 1947.

He was married at Marshall, Oct. 19, 1902, to Miss Louise Rennison. They were the parents of five children. One daughter died in infancy. Mrs. Renno died Oct. 27, 1954.

Mr. Renno was one of a family of 13 children. He was preceded in death by ten of his brothers and sisters.
