

## Death Sunday At Otterville To J. H. Gunn

OTTERVILLE—James Henry Gunn, 88, a former Missouri state senator, died of a heart attack yesterday at his home

Gunn, born near Barnett, Mo., moved to Otterville in 1893 with his family. In 1902 he joined the Otterville bank, of which he later served as president 30 years until 1961 when he suffered a stroke.

He was elected to the senate in 1926 and served two consecutive terms. He was mayor of Otterville in 1940 and 1950. He was a delegate to the state constitutional convention in 1922 in Jefferson City.

Gunn was a member of the Selective Service board of Cooper County for 20 years, a member of the Pleasant Grove Masonic lodge, Otterville, and was superintendent of the Sunday school at the Otterville Methodist church for 40 years.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Frances Nowlin Gunn, of the home.

Services will be held at 2 o'clock Tuesday at the church; burial in the Crown Hill cemetery, Sedalia. ✓
