Warner Robertson, Native of County, Dies at Age 96

Warner Whitlow Robertson, 96, a native Cooper countian, died at his home east of Boonville Thursday evening. He had been in failing health the past three months.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at the Goodman and Boller Funeral chapel with the Rev. Earl Clemons officiating. Burial will be in the Walnut Grove cemetery.

Mr. Robertson was born Sept. 12, 1868 in Cooper County on the farm where his death occurred. He was the son of John Robertson and Mary Potter Robertson. He was married in March, 1926 to Lelia Wilson and they made their home on the farm of his birth. Mr. Robertson was a member of the Baptist church.

Surviving are the wife of the home; one son, Charles Warner Robertson, of the home; and several nieces and nephews.

Mr. Robertson was the last remaining member of his family, having been preceded in death by two brothers and two sisters.
