Mrs. Lewis, 80, Bunceton Native, Dies in St. Louis

Mrs. Naomi Smith Lewis, 80, a native of Bunceton, died early today at the Masonic Home in St. Louis. Funeral arrangements are incomplete, pending the arrival of a brother from Texas, but will be announced by the William Wood Funeral Home.

Mrs. Lewis was the widow of Dr. W. C. Lewis, and the couple had lived in St. Louis during their married life. He died in 1923.

She was born at Bunceton on Jan. 25, 1885, the daughter of Peter Smith and Margaret Cordry Smith.

Survivors include two sisters, Mrs. T. A.
