John H. Rennison (Smithton)

John Harvey Rennison, 84 Route 1, Smithton, died at Bothwell Hospital at 3:45 p. m. Friday. He had been a patient at the hospital since Thursday evening.

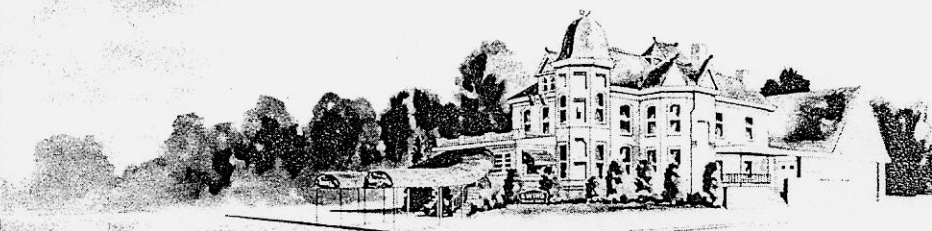
