N.B. Kirkpatrick Dies; Rites Set for Saturday

N.B. "Pat" Kirkpatrick, age 87, a lifelong resident of Cooper County, died at The Rest Haven at 11:15 a.m. Wednesday following a long illness.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Pisgah Baptist Church with the Rev. Earl Clemons officiating. Friends may call at the B.W. Thacher Funeral Home until 10 a.m. Friday, then at the Hornbeck-Thacher Funeral Home in Prairie Home until noon Satur-

day and then at the church.

Noland Burger Kirkpatrick was born near Prairie Home on August 24, 1878, the son of Robert Kirkpatrick and Nancy Lovell Kirkpatrick. He was married to Grace Lee Morris at Bunceton in 1915. She died in April, 1921. He later married Martha T. Johnson in St. Louis in 1929. Her death occurred in 1951.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Barbara Eldman, of Boonville; two sons, Robert M. Kirkpatrick of Prairie Home and Earl D. Kirkpatrick of Bunceton; six grandchildren and one great-granddaughter. He also leaves two brothers, Frank Kirkpatrick of Greeley, Colo., and Uel Kirkpatrick of Denver. Two sisters and three brothers preceded him in death.

Mr. Kirkpatrick was a member of the Prairie Home Baptist Church. He had farmed, was a merchant and had been a barber in Prairie Home until retirement.

Interment will be in the Pisgah Cemetery. ✓
