Mrs. Minnie Meyers Dies; services set For Wednesday

Mrs. Minnie B. Meyers, 87, died at St. Joseph Hospital at 8:15 a.m. Monday following a stroke Jan. 11 at her farm home near Martinsville.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday at the St. Martin's Catholic Church at Martinsville with the Rev. Father Luke Becker officiating. Burial will be in the SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Cemetery in Boonville. The Rosary Service will be held at 8 p.m. Tuesday at the William Wood Funeral Chapel. Wilhelmina Smith Meyers was born March 9, 1881, in the Lazy Bend community north of Pilot Grove, the daughter of John Smith and Mary Kessler Smith. She was the youngest daughter and last survivor of a family of nine children. She was married to John F. Meyers April 25, 1900. He preceded her in death July 9, 1956.
