### Grover Renno

Grover C. Renno, 75, 407 East Sixth, died at the Bothwell Hospital at 4:15 p.m. Saturday of an apparent heart attack.

Mr. Renno was born in Saline County, near Blackwater, Mo., Oct. 22, 1893, the son of the late William Mattison and Debra Marlin Renno.

One of a family of thirteen children, Mr. Renno was preceded in death by eleven of his brothers and sisters.

He was married at Sedalia on Nov. 8, 1913, to Miss Emma Zue Rennison. They were the parents of four children. One daughter, Mrs. Ruby Virginia Carter, died Aug. 26, 1956.

Mr. Renno spent his early life in Saline County where he attended the Fair Play School east of Marshall Junction.

He lived in Sedalia for the past thirty-two years.

Mr. Renno had been employed with the Home Lumber Company until he retired fifteen years ago.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. James (Edith) Taylor, Marshall; Mrs. Charles (Mary) Barnett, 1624 West 14th; one son, Grover W. Renno, 623 West 4th; one brother, Claude Renno, Nelson; nine grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

The body was taken to the Ewing Funeral Home.
