Wilbur Haley, 74, a native of Cooper County, died at Fulton Tuesday night following an illness of several months. Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Friday at the William Wood Funeral Chapel with burial in the Walnut Grove cemetery. Friends may call Thursday afternoon until time of service.

Mr. Haley was born in Cooper County Aug. 24, 1895, the son of William Haley and Ellen Seates Haley. He had been employed by the Missouri Power and Light Company for over 35 years. His wife, the late Ola Haley, preceded him in death in 1955. He was a member of the Baptist Church.
