Carl R. Stone Dies Monday

Carl R. Stone, 57, Rt. 2, Nelson, died Monday in Fitzgibbon Hospital.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Peninsula Church and burial will be in the Peninsula Cemetery.
