Herman Kosfeld, 80, a resident of Boonville and Cooper County most of his life, died at Cooper County Hospital at 3 p.m. Thursday.

Funeral services will be at 3 p.m. Saturday at the B.W. Thacher Funeral Home with the Rev. Melvin Lichts officiating. Burial will be in Walnut Grove Cemetery.

Herman Henry Kosfeld was born at Chamois on Feb. 16, 1891, the son of Frederick and Mary Johns Kosfeld. He was married to Altha Rentschler at Sedalia on March 22, 1912. Mrs. Kosfeld died in 1959.
