Alice Ann Smith, 15, Dies Sunday in Columbia

Alice Ann Smith, 15, 870 South Ellsworth, died Sunday at the University of Missouri Medical Center in Columbia. Her death was quite sudden and unexpected. An autopsy was performed this morning to determine the cause of death.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the Redeemer Lutheran Church with the pastor, Rev. O. Hellwege, officiating. Burial will be in Ridge Park Cemetery.

Visitation will be from seven to 8:30 o'clock Tuesday night at the Campbell-Lewis Chapel. The family suggests memorials to the Redeemer Lutheran Church.

Miss Smith was born in Marshall, October 29, 1959, the daughter of the late Howard P. Smith and Louise Bushnell Smith, who survives of the home. She had lived all of her life in Marshall, was a member of the Redeemer Lutheran Church and a fresh-
