Mrs. Florence Hurt, age 79 of Boonville, Mo., died Saturday evening at St. Mary's Hospital in Kansas City, Mo. after a long illness. Mrs. Hurt was born January 10, 1903, the daughter of Obadiah and Mary Ellen Nelson near Bunceton, Mo.
