### CLAUDE MORRIS

Warren Claude Morris, 70, of Blackwater, died Tuesday, March 6, 1985, at Cooper County Memorial Hospital.

Funeral services will be 2 p.m. Thursday at the Peninsula Baptist Church with the Rev. Frank Starr officiating. Burial will be in the Bunceton Masonic Cemetery.

Friends may call at the Thacher Funeral Home from noon Wednesday until noon Thursday, and then at the church. The family will receive friends from 7-8:30 p.m. Wednesday at the funeral home.

Mr. Morris was born Oct. 30, 1914, near Pisgah, the son of George Snode and Alberta Hughes Morris. He was married to Jessie Francis Daniel at Boonville on Oct. 22, 1934. She survives.

Other survivors include two sons, Claude Daniel Morris of Florissant and Francis Gilpin Morris of Blackwater; one daughter, Mrs. Linda
