Harold W. Cramer, 76, of rural Houstonia, Mo., died Tuesday, Oct. 23, 1990, at Bothwell Regional Health Center in Sedalia, Mo.

Graveside services will be held at 11 a.m., Friday, Oct. 26, at Salt Fork Cemetery near Nelson. Rev. Albert W. Bunch will officiate. Visitation is from 7 to 8:30 p.m. Thursday at Campbell-Lewis Funeral Home. Memorials are suggested to the American Cancer Society.
