Grace Cott, 79, Gilliam, Mo., formerly of Independence, died Wednesday, Oct. 14, 1992, at a hospital in Marshall, Mo.

Mrs. Cott was born in Gilliam and lived in Independence and North Kansas City before returning to Gilliam in 1951. She taught first grade in Independence and North Kansas City from 1941 to 1951, and retired from Slater (Mo.) Public School in 1977. She was a graduate of Central Missouri State College, Warrensburg, and was a member of the American Association of University Women. She was a member of the Fish Creek Baptist Church, south of Gilliam. Her husband, Lawrence Cott, died in 1989.

Her survivors include three brothers, Horace A. Huff, Sierra Vista, Ariz., Richard Farris Huff, Springfield, Mo., and Harry R. Huff, St. Louis; and two sisters, Doris Cott, Slater, and Agnes Cott, Miami, Mo.
