Amy Frances Nichols, 87, Otterville, died Friday, Jan. 7, 1994, at Bothwell Regional Health Center.

She was born July 26, 1906, in Otterville, daughter of Hiram Drane and Ida Frances Rennison Case. On Nov. 25, 1937, in Knob Noster, she married Thomas Benjamin Nichols, who survives of the home.
