Georgia Neal, 84, Topeka, Kan., formerly of Sedalia and Otterville, died Thursday, Jan. 12, 1995, at her home.

She was born Sept. 20, 1910, in Otterville, daughter of George and Sarah Jane Mock Jordon. On Dec. 15, 1928, she married the Rev. L.C. Neal, who died in 1989.

Mrs. Neal moved to Kansas City after her marriage. She taught school for 30 years, beginning in 1945. In 1957, she earned her bachelor's degree in elementary education from Fort Hays State University, Fort Hays, Kan. She lived in several Kansas towns, moving to Topeka in 1984.
