Nelson Earneston Stull, 64, of Columbia died Sunday, March 31, 1996, at University Hospital.

Services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Thursday, April 4, at Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints with Bishop Craig Israelson officiating.

Burial will be at Little Bonne Femme Cemetery. Visitation will be from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday, April 3, at Memorial Funeral Home.

Mr. Stull was born Oct. 9, 1931, to Cecil and Edna Foley Stull in Columbia.

He married Edith Ford on Dec. 23, 1954, in Columbia, and she survives.

Mr. Stull served in the Air Force from 1951 to 1955. He was an operator at University of Missouri Power Plant till he retired in 1985.
