**Logan T. Monsees, 1905-2002, Oklahoma**

Logan Theodore Monsees, 97, of Oklahoma, died Friday, July 12, 2002, at Greenbrier Nursing Home.

He was born Jan. 7, 1905, in Smithton, a son of Charles M. and Amelia Schleusing Monsees. On Nov. 26, 1930, he married Vivian Vaughan Monsees, who died Dec. 24, 1993.

Mr. Monsees worked at the Kansas City Star, The Daily Oklahoman and the Enid Morning News. He began publishing The Pictorial Mail in 1948. He continued to publish his paper until 1980, when he began concentrating on the oil and gas business with which he had been involved for many years. He was a Sunday school superintendent at First United Methodist Church. He was a member of the Parkinson Class and a member of the Noon Lions Club. He was an avid fisherman who also liked hunting. He enjoyed being a father and grandfather.

Surviving are a son, Charles W. Monsees of Enid; five grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother and two sisters.

Graveside services will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday at Garden Chapel of Memorial Park Cemetery with the Rev. David Wiggs officiating.
