Alma Baughman, 92, Boonville, formerly of Bunceton, Mo., died Saturday, May 29, 2004 at Boone Hospital Center in Columbia, Mo. Funeral services were Wednesday, June 2, 2004 at 2 p.m. at Bowlin-Cantriel Funeral Services in California, Mo. Rev. Dennis Farabee officiated the services.
