Samuel Louis "Sam" Kosfeld, 80

Samuel Louis "Sam" Kosfeld, 80, of Boonville passed away at Cooper County Memorial Hospital on Friday, Feb. 22, 2008.

Services for Samuel Kosfeld were held at Davis Funeral Chapel on Monday, Feb. 24, 2008 at 1 pm with Rev. Lewis Odneal officiating. Visitation was one hour prior to the service, from noon until time of service at the funeral chapel. Burial was in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery in New Franklin.

Samuel Louis Kosfeld was born in Overton, Mo. on Jan. 29, 1928, the son of Herman Henry Kosfeld and Altha Jane Rentschler Kosfeld. Sam served his country as a member of the National Guard and the Merchant Marines for forty-two years. He married Vallie Jean Rohlfig in May of 1984. Sam was a member of the Fraternal Order of the eagles. As a result of his career in the service, Sam loved to travel and he was a sportsman who lived to hunt and fish.

Besides his parents, Mr. Kosfeld was preceded in death by his wife, Vallie, and by his son, Sam Kosfeld, Jr., and by his brother, Joe Kosfeld and sisters, Florence Meyer and Pansy Rose. He is survived by his daughter, Samona Kosfeld and son Martin Roger Kosfeld both of Boonville. His sisters, Brookie McDowell, Mary Ann Fenton, Dottie Gerhardt and Annetta Hansett, all of Boonville and Carolyn Berry of San Diego, Calif. also survive.
