Road Directions: From Bunceton, Missouri go east one mile on Route "J" to Route "B", then south on "B" for 2 1/2 miles to gravel road; turn left (east) for 3/4 miles. Cemetery is on south (right) side of road about 1/4 mile into the field.

History:

"This cemetery was located on the old farm of John Chilton or John Ritchey." This list recorded by Mrs. Estelle née Cully Snow on March 15, 1967 and updated through December 1984.

"Chilton Cemetery" was established in 1812. The oldest stone dates from 1844. The cemetery was used by the Chilton family from 1844 through 1923. Also buried in this cemetery are soldiers of the War of 1812, slaves, and Indians. This cemetery is also once thought to be an Indian burial ground.
