History:

The cemetery is about eight yards by twelve yards and enclosed by a wrought fence. It is completely overgrown by brush.

Higgeson	James H.; died 05 Jun 1880; a footstone with "J. H." only marker
Higgeson	Joseph; died 25 Dec 1861; a storekeeper at Turley Bridge on the Lamine River. On Christmas morning 1861, he was robbed and murdered by a band of desperadoes
Higgeson	Nancy I. née Zachary; wife of Joseph Higgeson; died 1868
Unknown	Two limestone markers with cedar tree in between
Zachary	Lucy; died circa 1853; a sister of Nancy I. née Zachary Higgeson; Note: Her will is recorded in Cooper Co., Mo. Probate Court.
