History:

The cemetery was named after Reuben McFarland, who was born in North Carolina, one of eight children of Jacob and Nancy née Cathey McFarland.

Nancy Cathey was a daughter of George Cathey, a Revolutionary Soldier. These families all came to Missouri about 1816; to St. Genevieve County and lived there two years and then came to Cooper County, in 1818; and settled the land where they lived out the remainder of their lives. The cemetery had head stones and an iron fence around it, with tall cedar trees just outside the fence.
