History:

This plot is unfenced and in a very dilapidated condition. There are a number of unmarked graves and others are marked only by field stones. Several markers are broken so as to be illegible and a few sunken so deep as to be inaccessible.

Recorded by E. A. Cordry on 28 Dec 1970. Entries in red are from the Cooper County Record of Deaths.

Mr. Ted Nelson of Oak Grove, Missouri is a descendant of family members buried here. Recently (late 1990s) he and his wife, Glenda, canvassed this plot's other records and have added a number of names and dates and initials to the burials here. Mr. Nelson says that they did not give suggestions for the persons in the graves with the initial markers, because they would just be guessing. He also reported that they have records of persons buried at the "Nelson Cemetery at Vermont", but did not include them as they have not found their stones.
