History:

Sometime before 1918 a Mr. and Mrs. Rue came from Houston, Texas to Cooper County looking for information about an old Rue Family Burial Plot. The plot is on land near Harriston or Harris Station, a small village on the main line of the Missouri, Kansas & Texas Railroad, about 5 or 6 miles southwest of Pilot Grove. Their family had lived on land adjoining the Mary K. Sly land and there were a few grave markers found scattered around and near a small stream of drainage water. No one in that area seems to know just where the old burial plot had been located. A few years ago some of the family members came back to Cooper County and spent about a week trying to get more information. They visited several families in the New Lebanon area but did not give us anything new about the few names in our records.
