Ellis	John Marshall; Born: 22 July 1832; Died: 18 May 1841; son of T. J. & C. A. Ellis

Ellis	Mary; Born: 5 December 1836; Died: 19 May 1891; daughter of T. J. & C. A. Ellis
Ellis	Richard P.; Born: 6 November 1809; Died: 10 August 1862; a native of Virginia; came to Missouri in 1836; husband of Margaret V. née Ferguson Ellis, born: Bath Co., KY. Note: a squad of soldiers killed Richard P. Ellis and his nephew William Graves during the Civil War. His widow died at Pilot Grove, MO; many years later.

Ellis	Thomas J.; Born: 26 February 1801; Died: 1 August 1846; husband of Cynthia A. Ellis
Ellis	Win; "W. V. E." No other data: Note: These initials are on a marker in the cemetery: Note: most probably connection with footstone; born in Kentucky; died 30 Jul 1884 in Pilot Grove, Missouri; aged 76 years, 7 months, 10 days; buried 31 Jul 1884; widower; husband R. P. Ellis, Sr.; See Margaret V. née Ferguson Ellis
